## WHERE IS KUŞADASI?

---

**Kuşadası is a district of Aydın. Comprising 23 neighborhoods, it is one of Turkey's major tourism centers. There are several alternative ways to reach Kuşadası, which is connected to Aydın.**

### ***How to Get to Kuşadası?***

Kuşadası is 71 km from Aydın city center and 90 km from İzmir. Its distance from İstanbul is 570 km, while it is 647 km away from Ankara. Thanks to its proximity to these densely populated cities, transportation to Kuşadası is both easy and diverse. You can travel to Kuşadası from many cities such as İstanbul, Ankara, İzmir, and Bursa by intercity buses throughout the year. Although the number of services decreases outside the summer season, intercity buses still operate to Kuşadası in every season. If you wish to reach Kuşadası from İzmir, you can take advantage of the frequent bus services departing from İzmir Bus Terminal.

### ***Getting to Kuşadası by Plane***

To reach Kuşadası, you should land at the nearest airport. After landing, transportation options vary depending on your location. One of the closest airports to Kuşadası is İzmir Adnan Menderes Airport, located 82 km away. You can fly to İzmir Adnan Menderes Airport from any airport in Turkey with the airline of your choice. From major cities like İstanbul and Ankara, you can easily find direct flights. Transportation options between the airport and Kuşadası include:

- **HAVAŞ Buses:** Operating in coordination with flight arrival and departure times, HAVAŞ buses provide a comfortable and safe transfer to Kuşadası Bus Terminal. The journey usually takes about 90 minutes. In addition to HAVAŞ, there are also private transfer companies.
- **Taxi:** Especially for families or groups, taking a taxi can be an economical option. With some bargaining, you can reach the district directly from the airport.
- **Private Transfer & Car Rental:** Many car rental companies have offices at the airport. You can either rent a car or arrange a private chauffeured transfer to go directly to Kuşadası.

The nearest airport is İzmir Airport. In addition, both domestic and international travelers may also use Bodrum and Dalaman Airports to reach Kuşadası. The distance between Kuşadası and İzmir Airport is 95 km, to Bodrum Airport is 185 km, and to Dalaman Airport is 260 km.

### ***Getting to Kuşadası by Bus***

You can reach Kuşadası directly by bus from major cities such as İstanbul, Ankara, and İzmir without the need for transfers. There are direct intercity bus services to Kuşadası from all parts of Turkey.

### ***Getting to Kuşadası by Train***

For passengers who prefer to travel by rail, the nearest station is Çamlık Train Station, located about 13 kilometers from Kuşadası town center.

Regular train services operate to Çamlık from key locations such as İzmir, Selçuk, and Aydın. From Çamlık, you can easily reach the town center by taxi, minibus, or private transfer vehicles.

- **Çamlık Train Station:** Both TCDD regional trains and tourist-themed nostalgic trains stop at the station during certain periods.

- Traveling by train also offers a nostalgic experience, as it provides the chance to enjoy the natural beauty of the Aegean Region.

### ***Getting to Kuşadası by Sea***

Kuşadası Port is one of the most active cruise ports in the Aegean Sea, especially during the summer season, accommodating many cruise ships and tourists. In addition, regular ferry and sea bus services are organized to the Greek islands.

- **Cruise Services:** Many cruise lines departing from European cities include Kuşadası in their routes.
- **Ferry Services:** Seasonal ferry services operate to Samos Island and nearby Greek islands.
- **Marina:** Yacht tourism in the region is also well-developed, with modern marinas and docking facilities along the coast.

### ***Getting to Kuşadası by Car***

The distance between Aydın and Kuşadası is approximately 64 kilometers. There are two different routes from Istanbul, and you can choose either the highway or the sea bus, with the latter offering faster travel.

### **From Istanbul to Kuşadası**

The distance from Istanbul to Kuşadası is approximately 559 kilometers, and it takes about 7 hours by car. Recommended routes from Istanbul to Kuşadası include: Istanbul – Bursa – Balıkesir – Manisa – İzmir – Selçuk – Kuşadası.

### **From Ankara to Kuşadası**

The distance from Ankara to Kuşadası is about 650 kilometers, and it takes roughly 7 hours by car. Two possible routes from Ankara are:

Ankara – Uşak – Manisa – İzmir – Selçuk – Kuşadası

Ankara – Afyon – Denizli – Aydın – Kuşadası

### **From İzmir to Kuşadası**

The distance between İzmir and Kuşadası is about 95 kilometers, which takes approximately 1 hour by car. Two possible routes from İzmir include:

Take the highway to Selçuk first, then continue to Kuşadası.

From Gaziemir, pass through Menderes or Torbalı to reach Kuşadası.

### ***Minibuses and Municipal Buses from Aydın to Kuşadası***

The distance between Aydın city center and Kuşadası Bus Terminal is approximately 64 kilometers. To reach the city center, there are municipal buses and minibuses available.

From in front of Forum Aydın, you can take municipal bus number 403 to reach Kuşadası town center for 26 TL (price may vary). Municipal buses depart every 20 minutes on weekdays and every 30 minutes on weekends. Minibus (dolmuş) schedules from Aydın and Kuşadası vary between summer and winter. During summer time, the first minibus departs between 05:45 and 06:15, and the last one at 21:00.

## Local Transportation in Kuşadası

### Minibus Routes

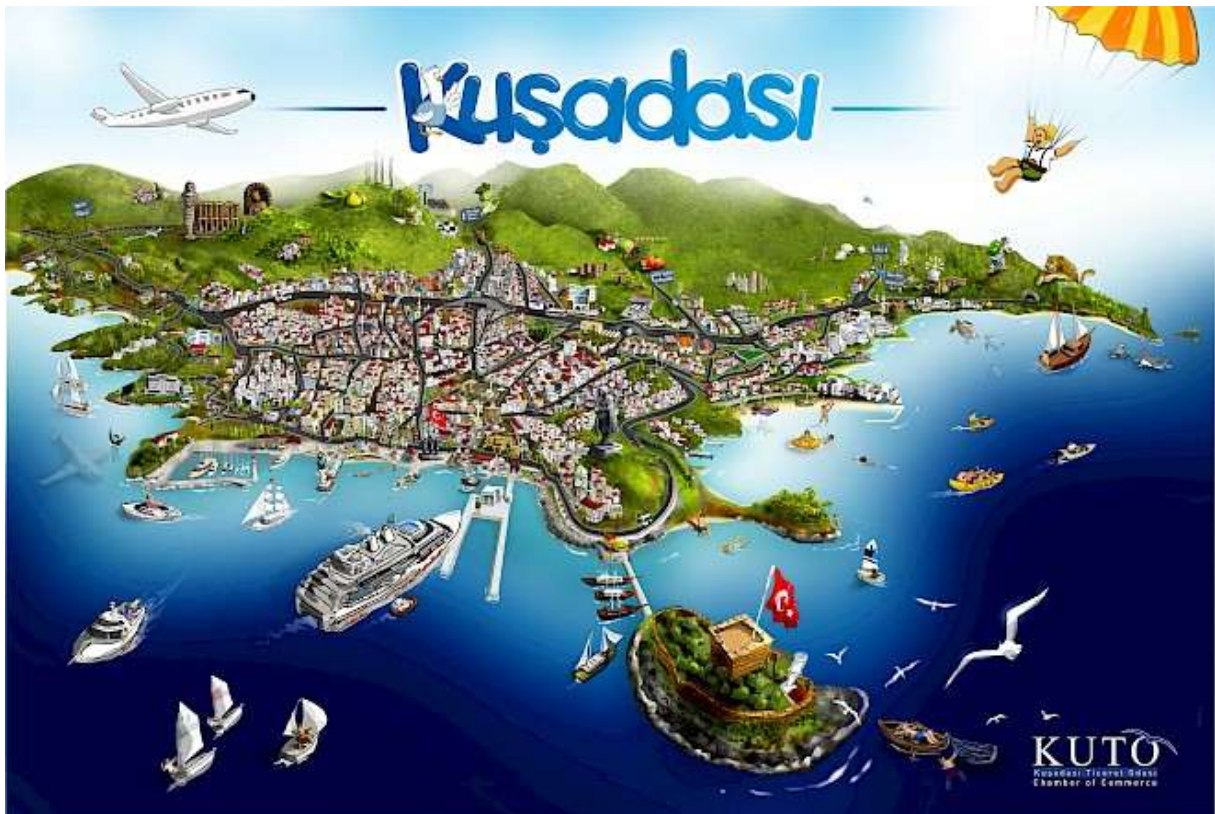
The most commonly used means of transport within Kuşadası are minibuses (dolmuş). Frequent services run from the town center along the coastline to districts such as Kadınlar Denizi, Davutlar, Güzelçamlı, Kuştur, Marina, and Yavansu.

- Minibus fares vary depending on the route, and additional services are added during the summer months to meet high demand.

- Minibuses operate from early morning until midnight, with route lengths ranging from 1–2 kilometers up to 20 kilometers.

### Bicycle and Walking Paths

Kuşadası is suitable for cycling due to the ease of traffic along the coastline and in the city center. Bicycle lanes have been constructed in some areas by the municipality, and for walking, the coastline and the area around Güvercinada are particularly popular.



## TRANSPORTATION IN SELÇUK

Selçuk, located approximately 75 km from İzmir city center, borders the districts of Torbalı, Tire, and Menderes in İzmir. Situated near the Aydın provincial border, Selçuk lies along the Aegean Sea coast.

An important historical and tourism center in İzmir, Selçuk gained district status in the 1950s. It is easily accessible from İzmir city center via the İzmir Highway, with an average travel time of about one hour by car.

### *Getting to Selçuk by Plane*

Selçuk can be reached by air via Adnan Menderes Airport, located in İzmir's Gazimir district. From there, traveling to Selçuk town center takes approximately 1–1.5 hours by İZBAN, around 1 hour by Selçuk minibuses, and about 1 hour via HAVAŞ shuttle services.

### *Getting to Selçuk by Bus*

There are direct bus services to Selçuk from major cities such as Istanbul and Ankara. Direct buses also operate from surrounding provinces like Aydın. If you are coming from other cities, you should get off at İzmir Bus Terminal and transfer to Selçuk via public transportation or HAVAŞ shuttles.

The bus journey from Istanbul to Selçuk takes approximately 8–9 hours.

From Ankara, it takes about 9–10 hours by bus.

If traveling from other cities, you can transfer to Selçuk from bus terminals in nearby districts.

### *Getting to Selçuk by Train*

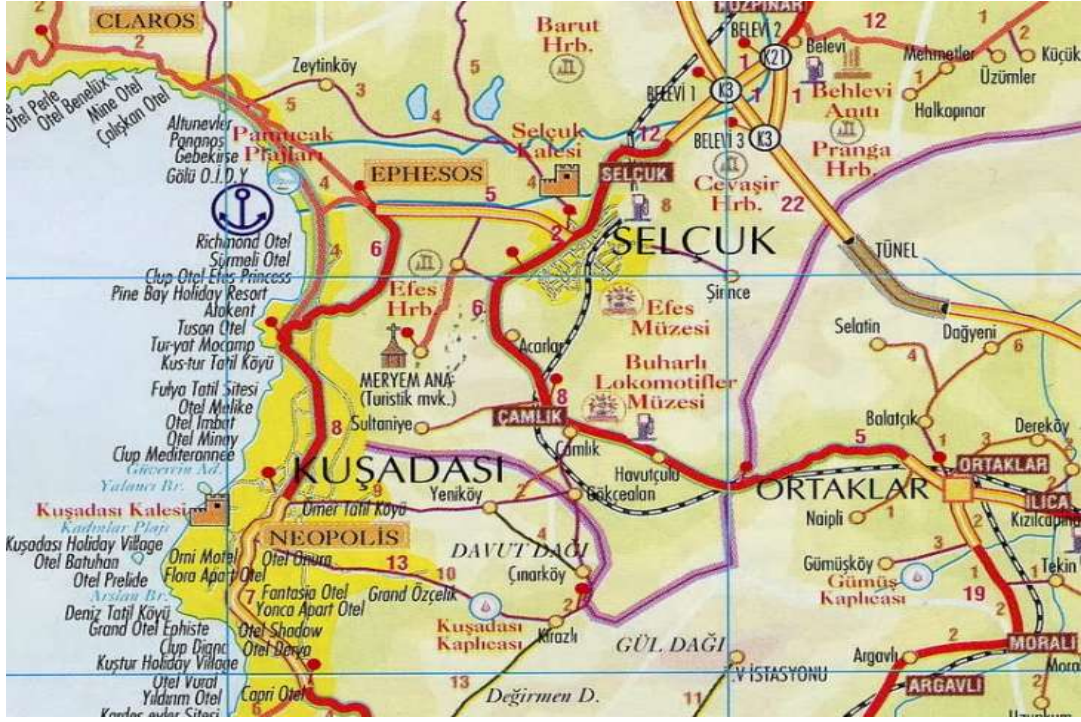
You can reach Selçuk by rail using the İzmir Mavi Train services. After arriving in İzmir's Basmane district with the Mavi Train, you can transfer to Selçuk via public transportation.

The İzmir Mavi Train operates between Ankara and İzmir, providing connections from Ankara, Eskişehir, Manisa, Balıkesir, and Kütahya. After arriving at Basmane Train Station in İzmir's Konak district, you can transfer to the Basmane–Selçuk train line.

The journey on the Mavi Train takes approximately 12–13 hours from Ankara to İzmir, around 10 hours from Eskişehir to İzmir, 4 hours from Balıkesir to İzmir, and 1.5–2 hours from Manisa to İzmir. The train ride from Basmane to Selçuk takes about 1 hour.
